Meeting was called to order at 5:45 p.m. by Ald. JoAnn Shaw.

ADOPTION OF MINUTES.

Motion was made by Ald. Wiese, seconded by Ald. Vukovic to approve the minutes of the meeting held on June 8, 2020. Ayes: Ald. Shaw, Vukovic, and Wiese. Noes: None. Abstain: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATION FOR LA BARBUE LLC (DBA MALLRAT), CLASS “B” (BEER) RETAILER LICENSE, AND “CLASS C” (WINE) RETAILER LICENSE, LOCATED AT 5694 NORTH CENTERPARK WAY.

City Administrator Rachel Safstrom explained the State of Wisconsin requires any business selling alcohol to have an Alcohol Beverage License. All other licenses have been approved for the current location and all background checks have been concluded by the City of Glendale Police Department. La Barbue LLC, DBA Mallrat, meets all the statutory requirement to be issued a Class “B” and “Class C” license. Proposed agent, Nat Davaur, was approved by the Police Department. All applications are on file in the Clerk’s office. The appropriate background checks were completed by the Police Department.

Ald. Wiese asked for clarification on the location of the business. Proposed agent, Nat Davaur, clarified it will be a food truck style van which will park on premises. Mr. Davaur stated the business is considering a permanent location in the previous Teavana space. Administrator Safstrom stated there are still liquor licenses available for Bayshore, should La Barbue require a full liquor license. Mr. Davaur stated there may be a change in his DBA name. Attorney Fuchs clarified if there is a DBA change, the clerk would need to be notified. However, if the LLC changes, the license process would need to be completed again. Mayor Kennedy questioned whether this is a “City” or “Bayshore” license. Administrator Safstrom clarified that as it is for beer and wine only, it does not utilize a full liquor license.

Motion was made by Ald. Vukovic, seconded by Ald. Wiese to recommend the Common Council approve the Class “B” (Beer) Retailer License, and “Class C” (Wine) Retailer License for La Barbue LLC (DBA Mallrat), located at 5694 North Centerpark Way.
