### EROSION CONTROL PLAN SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1 Every ground disturbing project must have a site-specific erosion control and stormwater management plan which utilizes Best Management Practices to avoid or minimize soil, sediment, and pollutants from being carried off-site during and after construction activity in accordance State of Wisconsin Statutes, Section NR 216 and NR 151 Wis. Adm. Code.
- 2 Construction sites with ground disturbing activities that are of one acre or more must submit a WRAPP (NOI) application to the WI-DNR at least 14 working days in advance. Issuance of a local erosion/stormwater permit is contingent upon providing proof of DNR permit issuance.
- 3 Proper sequencing of erosion control and stormwater management methods must be followed throughout the duration of the project in accordance with prescribed Best Management Practices.
- 4 Products for erosion and sediment control must meet DOT Technical Standards for approved materials. Fore more information visit: <http://wisconsinidot.gov/Pages/doing-bus/eng-consultants/cnslt-rsrcs/tools/pal/default.aspx>.
- 5 Applicant must inspect BMP's at least once every seven (7) days and within 24 hours after a precipitation event of 0.5 inches or more.
- 6 A MINIMUM of 70% vegetative coverage or permanent methods in place PRIOR to removal of BMP's.
