Official Notice - Snow and Ice Removal Requirements

This letter shall serve as official notice for the requirement of removing snow and ice from city sidewalks and handicapped curb ramps.

The following regulations will be enforced:

All Commercial, Industrial & Institutional Properties:

- City sidewalks and handicapped ramps must be cleared within 24 hours from the time snow ceases to fall.
- A minimum width of at least four (4') feet must be fully cleared for the entire length of the city sidewalk and ramp.
- Sidewalks and ramps must REMAIN CLEAR at all times.
- Access to walk signal buttons must be provided.
- Application of salt or sand IS NECESSARY when slippery conditions exist.

All Residential Properties:

- City sidewalks and handicapped ramps must be cleared within 24 hours from the time snow ceases to fall.
- A minimum width of at least two (2') feet must be cleared for the entire length of the city sidewalk and ramp.
- Sidewalks and ramps must REMAIN CLEAR at all times.
- Application of salt or sand IS NECESSARY when slippery conditions exist.

Inspections of all sidewalks and ramps will be conducted beginning 24 hours after snow ceases to fall. Any property found to be in violation of the above requirements will result in the City clearing the sidewalks and handicapped ramps with ALL expenses and fees charged to the homeowner and if unpaid, placed on the property tax bill as a special assessment.

Your cooperation and assistance in maintaining safe passage for pedestrians on the sidewalks and curb ramps for the handicapped in the City of Glendale is appreciated.
