

Kletzsch Park Fish Passage and Improved River Access Public Information Meeting



Milwaukee County Parks, in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, is exploring ideas for providing fish passage around the Kletzsch Park dam. The proposed fish passage will be designed to allow native fish species such as northern pike and lake sturgeon to move upstream.

Additionally, the popular viewing area along the Milwaukee River Parkway will be enhanced with an overlook, a portage for paddlers, an accessible walkway to the river, and an accessible fishing platform at the shoreline.
