**Noteworthy Calls for the Week**

**07/14/21-Traffic Stop-5500 Blk N. Green Bay Ave.**

Officer attempted a traffic stop but the vehicle fled upon officer contact. A pursuit ensued and ended when the suspect crashed into a residence in Milwaukee. The driver was taken into custody after brief foot pursuit. Suspect was issued several citations in addition to being transported to the county jail for additional charges.

**07/15/21-Disorderly Conduct-6300 Blk N. Port Washington Rd.**

Officers were dispatched for a disorderly conduct incident that occurred in the parking lot. The caller advised that one of the subjects was armed with a handgun. Upon contacting all parties involved, one subject was arrested for CCW, the second for disorderly conduct, and the third was released without any charges.

**07/16/21-Retail Theft-1700 Blk W. Silver Spring Dr.**

Caller reported a theft of \$197 worth of merchandise in which the suspect fled the scene. Subject was later located, arrested, booked, and ordered into Milwaukee Co. DA's Office.

**07/16/21-Entry to Vehicle-6500 Blk N. Pine Shore Dr.**

A squad was dispatched for an entry to vehicle, not in progress. The caller stated a vehicle was entered sometime overnight and that a 9mm gun was stolen from the center console.

**07/17/21-Suspicious Activity-1800 Blk. W. Silver Spring Dr.**

Squads were dispatched to the area for an adult subject passed out behind the wheel of a vehicle. The subject was put through SFSTs and subsequently arrested for OWI-1st and possession of cocaine. Male subject was transported to GLPD, cited, booked, and later released.

**07/18/21-Suspicious Activity-5500 Blk N. Port Washington Rd.**

An officer observed three vehicles in a parking lot which left upon seeing the squad car. The vehicles were later seen in a different parking lot, and multiple subjects were seen walking away from them. An investigation found narcotics and guns inside the vehicles. Suspects were located and five arrests were made. Three of the subjects were referred to the Milwaukee County DA's Office for charging.

**07/18/21-Entry to Vehicle-4800 Blk N. Lydell Ave.**

The caller reported hearing glass break in the parking lot and observed unknown subjects nearby. The officer observed a silver sedan with the rear driver side window smashed and contacted the owner. A short time later suspects matching the description were pursued by a neighboring agency and taken into custody.

**07/19/21-Shots Fired-6100 Blk N. Green Bay Ave.**

Report of several shots fired. Three subjects shot at each other and fled the scene.

**07/20/21-Traffic Stop-6000 Blk N. Green Bay Ave.**

A vehicle fled after an attempted traffic stop. A pursuit ensued but was terminated after the vehicle missed the deployed Stop Sticks. The vehicle was located after crashing in Milwaukee. A resident advised that subject was hiding under a vehicle nearby. Officers searched the area along with K9 Brix and the subject was apprehended soon after.
